NOTICE OF ELECTION BOARD OF TRUSTEES GOVERNMENT OF GUAM RETIREMENT FUND (GGRF)

Pursuant to Chapter 3 of Article 4, Title 2 of the Guam Administrative Rules and Regulations (GAR), Notice is hereby given that an election for the Board of Trustees of the Government of Guam Retirement Fund will be conducted by the Guam Election Commission (GEC).

Elected Offices: Active Member (2 Offices)
 Retiree Member (2 Offices)

Time: 7:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

Date: Saturday, June 27, 2009

Location: University of Guam Field House, Mangilao

The purpose of the election is to elect Active and Retiree members to serve on the Board of Trustees of the Government of Guam Retirement Fund (GGRF).

The term of office of a Trustee is five (5) years from the date the Trustee first takes the oath of office following the Trustee's election.

Upon Notice of an Election, a prospective Candidate seeking election shall submit a Candidate Statement and a Nomination Petition in the form provided by the Board. Said Nomination Petition shall be signed by no less than one hundred fifty (150) persons who are eligible to vote as members or retirees of the Fund or Retirement System. A prospective Candidate shall indicate on the Candidate Statement whether he/she seeks Office as an Active Member or a Retiree. If the prospective Candidate seeks nomination as a Retiree, the prospective Candidate shall certify that he/she is domiciled in Guam. **Candidate's packets are available at the Guam Election Commission (2nd Flr GCIC Bldg in Hagåtña) 8am-5pm Monday through Friday. The submission deadline for Nominating Petitions will be the close of business (5pm) Tuesday, April 28, 2009.**

Beginning **Wednesday, March 4, 2009**, the Guam Election Commission will begin accepting Absentee Ballot Applications from eligible voters who are home bound; who are off-island, or will be off-island on the day of the election.
