## DEFINED CONTRIBUTION

## I. ATTENDANCE, QUORUM, AND CALL TO ORDER

After determining a quorum was present, the Retirement Fund Board of Trustees Regular Meeting for the Defined Contribution Plan was called to order at 12:31 p.m. Friday, January 19,2024, in the Retirement Fund Conference Room. Vice Chair Antolina Leon Guerrero presided.

## V. DIRECTOR'S REPORT - EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

1. Standard Insurance - An updated summary report as of December on the status of applications and individuals on Group Long Term Disability (LTD) is provided for the Board's information. There are 42 active claims as of December 31, 2023.

#### Financial Report

- 1. Contributions Director Paula Blas stated that as of January 17, 2024, all agencies are current with their Fiscal Year 2024 employee and employer contributions.
- **2.** Financial Statements Director Blas stated that the books for the month ended December 2023 are scheduled to close at the end of January 2024.

#### VI. THIRD PARTY ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

A. Contribution Report – August 2023

Director Blas stated that Alice Taijeron, Director, Client Relations & Participant Engagement, Empower, provided the TPA Report for the month ended December 31, 2023 on the DC Retirement System 401(a) Plan and the 457 Deferred Compensation Plan.

Mrs. Taijeron stated that the 401(a) Plan had total assets of \$528,882,175.32. There was an increase of \$28,493,851.44 or 5.69% from the previous month. The market effect was 91% of the 5.69%. The 457 Plan had total assets of \$148,966,853.74. There was an increase of \$7,923,182.94 or 5.62% from the previous month. The market effect was 91% of the 5.62%.

Mrs. Taijeron stated that there was one retiree in the month of December. Mrs. Taijeron pointed out that there were 1,096 walk-ins.

Vice-Chair Leon Guerrero asked if there were any concerns coming from participants. Mrs. Taijeron stated that in regards to the DC to DB 1.75 transfers a few participants came in inquiring about accessing their funds and they were referred to GGRF to see what options are available.

Treasurer Hernandez asked about the number of employees who do post-tax and pre-tax on their retirement plans. Mrs. Taijeron stated that the post-tax is the Roth account and they do not have the exact numbers but she will look it up.

Ms. Taijeron provided the following updates:

- At the beginning of January emails were sent out to participants to follow up with their retirement account to see if there is anything else Empower could assist them with.
- Guam Empower Team is currently working towards securing Financial Advisor licenses. The goal is to have two or at least one staff member licensed by the end of the second quarter. The Guam Empower team has different licenses and is preparing to take the Series 65 license exam. At this time, interested DC participants will be directed to someone stateside for Financial Advice.
